GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of Leverett, qualified to vote in the Town affairs, to meet in the **LEVERETT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GYMNASIUM** at said Leverett, on **MONDAY, JUNE 9, 2003 at 6:30 in the EVENING** (6:30 p.m.) then and there to act on the following articles, namely:

Article One: To see if the Town will vote to approve an amendment to the Amherst-Pelham Regional School District agreement reallocating the total amount to be contributed by the member towns to the District for fiscal year 2004, as required under the Agreement, so that each town's contribution, including the statutorily required minimum district contribution, increases by an equal percentage in proportion to its contribution for fiscal year 2003, such amendment shall apply to fiscal year 2004 only, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article Two: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Free Cash Account \$11,048.51 to the Snow and Ice Expense Account and \$5,472.03 to the Snow and Ice Salary Account, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article Three: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Road Machinery Fund \$1,214.67 to the Highway Equipment Account, or take any other action relative thereto.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up copies thereof on the post office and in the Town Hall and Congregational Church at Leverett, also the Baptist Church at North Leverett and the Village Co-op at Moores Comer, fourteen days at least before the day of said meeting.
