


### Q4 Rank the possible goals for this process by level of importance to you.



# Q14 We are starting to plan for our listening sessions. Are you interested in being part of a small group discussion?






### Q15 If yes, how many meetings of the small group would you be willing to attend?

# Q16 What time of day would be best for you? Please choose all days that apply and the best time for each day.


