

Meeting Date: 04/07/2008

Meeting Started: 7:00 PM

Board Members Present: Fair, Dauchy, Goscenski, Hillman, Zipkowitz (Clerk: Glen Ayers)

1. a.) Hillman moves to approve the minutes from 03/03/08, as amended. Fair seconds, all vote in approval.

1. b.) Fair moves to approve the minutes from 03/17/08, as amended. Hillman seconds, Dauchy, Hillman, and Fair voted in approval, Zipkowitz and Goscenski abstained.

2.) Received from Quabbin Analytical Labs, Bacteriological Report for the Village Coop Public Water Supply (Pws ID# 1154000), **180 Rattlesnake Gutter Road**, dated 3/5/2008, indicating that the water tested was free from bacterial contamination.

3.) The Board will be sending out reminders to the owners of Presby Systems that have been installed for one year that the systems need to be inspected. This is an annual inspection requirement.

4.) The Board approved a request for a beaver removal permit at **257 Montague Road** (Bercuvitz, owner). The rising water level is threatening their Dauchy signed the permit.

5.) Deanna Allen, **51 Montague Road** came in to discuss drilling a well to replace her shallow well. Her location is in the Aquifer Protection District, so the Board advised her that the goal for sighting her well should be to have it at least 150 feet from her septic leach field. The Board advised her that she will need to consult with the Conservation Commission. She was given the Leverett well regs and a well permit application.

6.) Fair reported on his attendance at the Planning Board hearing on the proposed zoning regs.

7.) The Board received a copy of a letter sent to the Select Board from Deirdre Cabral at DEP's Drinking Water Program, indicating that the existing non-conforming Town Hall well is not considered a Public Water Supply based on current usage. However, if the Town decides to drill a new well, DEP recommends that the well be located so that it meets the setback requirements for a PWS, so that it could be used that way in the future.
