

# 1. WIREFRAME: Town Website and Digital Storage for Digital Vault materials

## LHC

Style: official Government/admin information/transparency and access page

*LHC page —*

- what LHC does,
- who LHC are,
- agendas, meeting minutes, etc.

*LHC documents:*

- Projects spreadsheet
- Strategic plan
- Mission and vision, etc.

Maintenance: committee/town interface: Bi-weekly LHC updates with current documents: minutes, upcoming meetings, etc. Posting of documents, announcements.

## Leverett History

Style: Attractive information page with pics

Pictures

Minimal maintenance — eg quarterly update of links as they break or evolve — essentially a static page for people to read or use for referrals.

LINKS to groups and places with collections

LINKS to groups with Historical buildings, etc.

## Digital Vault public access (Page on website)

Style: like a library catalog as it were

List of what's in the vault physically

List of what's been digitized with links to the materials themselves:

- stored in the digital vault itself
- stored at Internet Archive

List of LHC digital materials that are of interest to the public with links to the materials -

Maintenance: LHC Updating as new materials are put in the vault, e.g. monthly: Adding text to lists with links to the vault or other online materials

## LHC Projects (maybe)

Style: Online "exhibit"

Media Presented in a user-friendly and interesting fashion with a paragraph each and embedded players, etc.

Links to the products/research in the Digital Vault eg interview transcriptions

Oral Histories

Maintenance: Essentially a static page but updates when new projects create materials or new materials from projects go into the vault on a project basis. Perhaps quarterly maintenance and every 6 months updates if necessary.

**Internet Archive:** Independent nonprofit that stores in the Cloud — only for library/archive materials

## Digital Storage Vault:

- Online storage AND/OR
- Town/small server in Town Hall

- Materials from the vault that have been digitized have a "home" here ( and many also on the Internet Archive)
- Digital documents and materials and products of the Leverett Historical Commission are stored here: One room schoolhouse files, Oral history files, ASoWYA Files, slideshows, pics, etc.
- Room for other digital files from the Town Clerk?

Maintenance: Uploading media and text files as they are produced or in monthly batches, depending on how actively digitizing and/or projects are happening. Adding categories when new types of materials or new projects are added

### Town Vault public access

NOTE: because items are stored in more than one place, it does not necessarily work to simply give direct access to the digital vault. This page is a portal to more than one type of storage and information. **Slow dynamic**

### **Suggestion: Network Attached Storage**

- **Disk Storage Capacity** that is attached to a network so that various people can use it.
- **In this case:** located in the Town Hall and connected to the Internet
- **Cost:** Under \$500 likely or even under \$250? No fees
- **Accessible** directly to LHC members or to the public via a special account or computer in the Town Hall, all TBD
- **Accessible** to the public via links on the the Digital Vault Public access interface on the Town Website.
