Dudleyville Road Drainage Project Update

October 8, 2025

The Dudleyville Road Drainage Improvement Project, which is funded through a \$1 million grant from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, has been awarded to Ludlow Construction, Inc. The purpose of this project is to replace existing drainage culverts that cross the roadway and to improve the drainage swales along the roadside to better control the stormwater on Dudleyville Road.

Construction is anticipated to begin on October 20th and will begin with materials and equipment brought to the site and detour signs installed. Construction is expected to last until December 2025, with final surface restorations to be completed in Spring 2026.

During construction, the road will be closed to thru traffic from 7 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday (while the Contractor is actively working) and will be reopened each evening. Due to the nature of the work, residents may need to access their properties via a detour on Montague Road in Shutesbury during the day. Please be prepared to use the detour and for slower driving during this construction period.
